

Student serving in Kids Ministry Guidelines

1. Parents must be in agreement to the guidelines.
2. Parents and student must sign the contract.

Expectations and Responsibilities

1. Students are expected to be there on the day assigned.
2. Students are to have a good attitude while serving.
3. Students are to be good examples to the kids.
4. Students are to complete the job they volunteer for.
5. If you are going to be gone, you must let Pastor Josh or Karla Kincaid know ahead of time.
6. If you do not follow the guidelines then you take yourself out of the volunteer position.
7. The goal is to serve 2 Sundays a month and be in a worship service 2 Sundays a month.
8. 6th Graders must work with K-2 grade or lower.
9. 7th-8th Graders can work with 5th grade and down.
10. You must abide by all guidelines set up in Kids Church and follow the leadership that is in place.
11. My position lasts from September through May.
12. You report directly to Pastor Josh or Karla Kincaid.

Please contact Pastor Josh if and when you want to serve and he will get you scheduled in the area you desire.

Areas of Service

1. Craft Helpers
 - a. Make sure the crafts are organized ahead of time (Sunday morning).
 - b. Distribute the crafts to each table.
 - c. Get anything the small group leaders need.
 - d. Clean up between groups.
 - e. 1st service clean up and prepare the room for 2nd service.
 - i. Clean up tables
 - ii. Organize craft table
 - iii. Put games back out on tables
 - iv. Straighten chairs
2. Lesson Helpers
 - a. Sit with kids during the lesson time.
 - b. Help them listen.
 - c. Do not distract from the teaching.
 - d. Help in any way possible.
3. Small Group Helpers
 - a. Sit with your small group each week.
 - b. Assist the kids with the craft.
 - c. Assist the small group leader.
 - d. Get to know the kids and become a friend to them.
4. Activity Time Helpers
 - a. Play games with the kids.
 - b. Make sure that sharing is occurring and no arguments are happening.
 - c. Let the kids play.
 - d. Get to know the kids and become a friend to them.
